THE FLY ZONE

FLY ZONE TERRAIN PARK

Nearly a mile long, the Fly Zone Terrain Park at Golden Peak features the Superpipe, four wide jumps, rails and lifts, the Fly Park and a Vail's unique log rails. It's also home to the Nordic Skiing Snowboard International in January.

THE AVIATOR

AVIATOR TERRAIN PARK

Located on Beaver trail under the gondola in Lionshead, Aviator Park features a combination of small and medium hits, rails and boxes designed for freestyle progression and a beginner half pipe with 12-foot walls.

THE FLIGHT BLUE

FLIGHT BLUE TERRAIN PARK

Flight School is Ski and Snowboard School's learning park. Located next to Fly Zone at Golden Peak. This new location for Flight School offers amazing views of Fly Zone, but has its own separate entrance.

THE SKY WAY

SKY WAY TERRAIN PARK

Sky Way Park is located at nearly 10,000 feet on Harky Cove trail and offers "ground-to" boxes, rails and more hits designed for those just starting out.
